The new gym will have the very latest Precor equipment, which we hope will help the enjoyment of your workouts. We have tried to keep the disruption to an absolute minimum and apologise for any inconvenience caused. All current gym members of Brackley Leisure Centre will have their membership collection reduced by 2 days in October 2016 as a result of the September closure.

ONLINE BOOKING

If you wish to make any bookings, the terms that apply across all our Leisure Centres are as follows:

- Members can book 10 days in advance
- Non Members (casual customers) can book 3 days in advance.
- All online accounts will be closed and will need to be re-registered to link the new Legacy accounts. We will send an email the first week in September to communicate the process.
- Online bookings will be down for the last 7 days of August and the first 7 days in September.

BRACKLEY LEISURE CENTRE DEVELOPMENTS

A new extension to Brackley Leisure Centre will see a state of the art facility added including a 25 metre swimming pool, learner pool, dedicated spin studio and 110 station fitness suite. We will continue to keep you updated of the building programme and will minimise the disruption as much as we can.



TOWCESTER GYM IMPROVEMENTS

Towcester Centre for Leisure will have a new gym installed from the 1st of September 2016. This will involve new gym equipment, new flooring and decor. We are not permitted to deliver the equipment before this time and this will result in a closure until the 8th of September 2016. The new gym will have the very latest Precor equipment, which we hope will help the enjoyment of your workouts. We have tried to keep the disruption to an absolute minimum and apologise for any inconvenience caused. The dry side changing rooms will also be closed at this time for modernisation works. All current members will have their membership collection reduced by 7 days in October as a result of the September closure.

A parking extension project will commence from Thursday 1st September 2016, meaning the top section of the car park will be unavailable for approximately 6 weeks. This will create an additional 26 bays for the long term. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.

The Café will undergo a transformation with new decor, furniture and menus. In order to make the change the café will be closed for a couple of days in the middle of September. The newly branded Café Vita will provide a wide range of healthy snacks including hot and cold drinks.
